- ⇒ File format: **MS Word (.doc / .docx)**
- ⇒ Selected papers shall be presented in **PPT format**

- ⇒ Online/virtual presentations will not be permitted under any circumstances

- ⇒ Line Spacing: 1.5
- ⇒ Margins: 1 inch on all sides
- ⇒ Alignment: Justified
